

HYGIENE AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS DURING LIVIKO DISTILLERY FACTORY TOUR

I am aware that:

- The Liviko territory and premises are equipped with cameras for security reasons
- On Liviko territory, movement is only allowed when accompanied and only in areas designated by the guide (passing under barrier tapes is prohibited)
- In production areas, it is not allowed to eat, drink, smoke (including the use of other tobacco products), or chew gum
- Hygiene requirements must be followed according to the instructions of the company representative:
 - in production areas, hygiene clothing must be worn (coat and hat) and disposable shoe covers
 - long hair must be secured under the hat (the hat must also cover bangs and hair at the nape)
 - all dangling jewelry must be removed (small earrings must be covered by the hat) and rings (except a plain wedding ring)
 - hands must be washed and disinfected before entering production areas
 - if you have a beard (longer than 5 mm), a beard cover must be worn
- All safety requirements must be followed in production areas: the visitor must follow safety signs; touching equipment/tools, etc. is prohibited; the visitor must move carefully in production areas (e.g., when passing ladders, hoses on the floor, etc.)
- Personal items (handbag, backpack, etc.) are not allowed in production areas. They can be stored, if desired, in lockable lockers.
- Photography and filming are not allowed in production areas (except under the guidance of the escort and in designated areas)
- Guests who are intoxicated are not allowed into Liviko production areas/factory tours
- Guests are not allowed into Liviko production areas/factory tours if they:
 - have experienced vomiting/diarrhea within the last 24 hours
 - have had tuberculosis, dysentery, salmonellosis, or typhoid fever within the last month
 - show symptoms of an acute viral infection or other food safety-related illness
 - have had or been in contact with a COVID-19 positive person within the last 48 hours
- The company representative has the right to remove a visitor from the factory tour or deny access to production areas if the visitor fails to comply with the rules.
